Next Friday, 15th of November, Ifunanya Chukwuewuzie (5th year) will be participating in the inaugural RTE Youth Assembly on climate. The day long gathering is an opportunity for 157 young people from all 26 counties of the state to debate, discuss and determine their proposals for climate action. The Youth Assembly will be chaired by Ceann Comhairle, Sean O'Fearghail.



Two sessions taking place in the Dáil chamber will be televised live on RTE 2 and RTE News Now from 9:55am-10:35am and 1.40pm-2.35pm.
